

Variations on “Beanies for Babies”

The yarn used was leftovers of either Patons “Astra”, Sidar “ double knitting” or Bernat “Baby Softee”. 3.75mm & 4mm needles

Bramble or Popcorn Stitch Beanie (variation on original pattern)

Using 3.75 mm needles cast on 56 stitches.

Work in ribbing (K2 P2) for 8 to 10 rows.

Change to 4mm needles

With wrong side of work facing you – increase ten stitches during the first row of pattern (66 sts)

Row 1 Purl

Row 2 K1, (K1, P1, K1, all into the next stitch), P3 together, repeat until last stitch, K1.

Row 3 Purl

Row 4 K1, P3 together, (K1, P1, K1, all into the next stitch), repeat until last stitch, K1.

Repeat until piece measures 5 inches (13 cm)

Shape Top

Row 1 K2tog K2, repeat to end of row

Row 2 Purl

Row 3 K2tog K2, repeat to end of row

Row 4 Purl

Row 5 K2tog K1, repeat to end of row

Row 6 Purl

Row 7 K2tog, repeat to end of row. Cut yarn, leaving a long end. Thread yarn into darning needle and draw through remaining stitches on needle. Draw up tightly and fasten securely. Sew seam. Turn up cuff. ♪

Striped Beanie

Knit 2 rows one colour and then 2 rows of a contrast colour. (56 stitches used through out)

10 rows of ribbing (K2, P2.)

and then stocking stitch – knit one row, purl the next row. Then “Shape Top” and finish as above.
